ON THE DAY

What the assessment involves

Functional Skills are assessed by NCFE rather than by us, online and invigilated. We arrange the sitting with you and you take it when your tutor agrees you are ready, so nothing about it should come as a surprise.



Five working days before

You receive a technical checklist by email and on the learning environment: the date and time, the platform and how to log in, what you need, and what to do if something goes wrong.



Checked before, not during

We confirm your NCFE registration and that the platform is working ahead of the sitting, rather than discovering a problem while you are trying to sit it.



An invigilator supervises

Under NCFE and JCQ rules, which are explained to you at the start: no other websites, no notes and no AI tools. Where remote proctoring is used you are told in advance and your consent is recorded.



If your internet fails

That is grounds for special consideration, not a mark against you. Tell us and we deal with it under the policy rather than leaving you to argue for it.

How long does NCFE Entry Level 2 Functional Skills Qualification in English take?

This qualification carries 55 guided learning hours. It is studied online at your own pace, so how long it takes in calendar time depends on how much you can commit each week.

What do I need before I can start?

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification. We assess every applicant individually and will tell you if a different level would suit you better.
